



STUART GREEN & BIG SPOON ART STUDIO

Visual Opportunity and sculptural challenge might be thought of as the two halves of Stuart Green's art practice. One side is continually and opportunistically looking at the world for forms, ideas, materials and pattern, casting the net wide for stimulus.

The other side is testing these materials and the ideas against the constraints or challenges of scale, materiality and context of the project.

These two directions are put to task on the recurring themes of his work; these are 'field and energy', 'line and spatial drawing', and 'the object encountered'.

Stuart Green graduated from WAIT in 1983 with a Bachelor of Education specialising in secondary Art. He did a double major in painting and sculpture. Deciding not to teach in secondary schools, he set up a studio in Melbourne for professional arts practice, later returning to Perth where he continued this practice. Prior to 1992 this studio based work resulted in numerous group and two solo exhibitions of sculpture and painting. During this time Stuart also taught part-time in each of Perth's university fine art schools. Following this his larger scale public sculptural works started to take priority.

For the last 30 years Stuart Green has concentrated on creating artworks for public spaces. He has extensive experience in designing and creating large and medium scale stand-alone artworks as well as integrated architectural, lighting and landscape-based works. He formed Big Spoon Art Services in 2008 to facilitate this work. Recent major works include *FIZZ*, the eastern façade of Perth Children's Hospital, *Crossings* Melbourne, *Cumulus* Sydney, *Red Cloud* Brisbane, *One of Many* China and *Droplet* Canberra.

Big Spoon Art Studio has acted as mentor and working partner with three local indigenous artists to further their major commissioned artwork. Working first with Shane Pickett on the Armadale Interpretive Centre, then Lance Chadd/Tjyllyungoo on the Yagan Square Statement artwork. Big Spoon has recently worked with Sandra Hill, completing her Stolen Generation Acknowledgement artwork in Wellington Square Perth

Big Spoon Art Studio is now a thriving hub of art creation, employing five permanent full-time staff operating out of the main studio premises in Bayswater Perth. Works are currently in train for various commissions locally and around Australia.
